Eaton Plumbing: Founded In 1974, Team Approach Continues To Pay Dividends



Eaton Plumbing Foreman Jeff Combs—seen opposite and above operating a Takeuchi TB235-2 excavator at Epcon Communities' The Courtyards at Clear Creek development north of Columbus, Ohio—has been with the company 12 years. From experience, he finds Takeuchi's power, comfort and versatility superior to competitive brands.

Max Eaton, the second-generation owner of Eaton Plumbing, is more than willing to give credit where credit is due for the company's success. First off, there's his father—company founder John (Jack) Eaton—who started the company in the family garage in Westerville in 1974. Jack grew the company to nearly 60 employees specializing in residential plumbing, both new construction and residential service.

The second place where Eaton gives credit is the company's employees. "They have a great work ethic, and our contractors know that," he said. "I can sell stuff, but if the team can't do it, it doesn't matter. We don't operate like a lot of companies that have managers who drive around all day. Our management team are all field-working guys. We want everyone to hold each other accountable."

To make sure employees are happy, the company allows crew members to switch roles "from slab-ongrade to doing service or working in custom homes. We don't want anyone to feel stuck in a position," he added.

Eaton Plumbing primarily works in the greater Columbus area, currently a booming market, Eaton noted. Recent projects include a 120-unit apartment complex in Pataskala, where crews did everything from underground sewer and water lines to finishing out the plumbing in each apartment.

The company also works in new home subdivisions for builders such as D.R. Horton, Ryan Homes and Epcon Communities. Eaton assigns dedicated crews to each builder so "it's not a learning curve. Every builder has its own quirks on how they like to see things done," and crews that work with the builder day in and day out can best meet those expectations, Eaton explained.

Meeting and exceeding expectations is kind of a theme at Eaton Plumbing, and that's the reason the company counts on Takeuchi compact equipment from Columbus Equipment Company. Eaton knows Takeuchis always perform as expected. Currently, the company owns TB235-B and TB240 compact excavators and a TL6CR track loader.

"We buy them because they are reliable and

durable," Eaton said. How durable? Eaton gave the first Takeuchi the company bought in the late 90s to a diesel mechanic friend because it needed repairs. "He got it running and it still runs today."

Eaton believes Takeuchi makes "the best mini excavators on the market. They're also powerful. We've rented numerous pieces of equipment when we're busy, and if we end up with a different brand, our operators get so frustrated because the performance is nowhere near what it is with our Takeuchi equipment."

"I haven't seen the issues I've heard of with other machines," he added. So replacing an old Takeuchi with a new one is "a no-brainer," in his opinion.

He also credits Columbus Equipment Company with providing excellent service in maintaining the equipment. His crews can handle basic maintenance, but Eaton doesn't employ a mechanic. "If it's an issue with the engine or something, it's not worth our time to try and fix it. I'd rather call Columbus Equipment Company."

He appreciates the dealership's field service option so that he doesn't always have to take the equipment in for service. "Some of our machines dig five days a week. Time is money when they're down."

Columbus Equipment Company sales rep Cory VanHouten has always been very helpful, Eaton

added. "His response to anything we need has always been exemplary."

Max Eaton didn't always intend to work for the family business. After graduating college, he worked in Cincinnati for a few years before asking his father if he could join the company. Jack started Max as an apprentice plumber working in the field.

"I hated it," Max recalled, but he realizes the experience was valuable. "I couldn't do my job today if I didn't have that experience. I'm not asking anyone to do anything I haven't done."

In 2018, he bought the company from his father, who officially retired. It took a while for some people to adjust to the change, he said, but "luckily we had the right team with us to forge the future." As a result, the company has grown substantially in the last few years.

Looking forward, Eaton expects the company to continue to grow. "Our future and growth can be as high as our management team wants to take it. We want to take on new work and continue to be a factor in the Columbus market," he said.

Then he spread the credit around. "Our guys take pride in performing at a high level. The biggest thing is that it's all about the guys doing the work. Without them, we're nothing."
